SUMMER RESIDENCY OPPORTUNITY

Pin-up launches its inaugural Summer Residency program with an exciting opportunity for Melbourne-based architects, designers and artists to work in-situ within the Pin-up gallery over the summer period to produce a project or body of work.

In consultation with the Pin-up creative team, the output of the Summer Residency will form the launch exhibition for 2012.

Residency Criteria (please address in brief):

- The work should engage with issues relating to architecture and design but does not necessarily have to be specific to the profession - please address in relation to your work.
- The Summer Residency is an open brief project - please briefly describe the conceptual ideology of the project or work
- Ideally a project or body of work will be produced within the residency timeframe noting that it may be a work-in-progress outcome - briefly describe how this will be achieved.
- An exhibition will be developed to support the work in discussion with the Pin-up curatorial team for mid-February, 2012. Please briefly describe envisaged production requirements keeping in mind budget constraints
- The practitioner must have relevant insurances in place for materials and work throughout the Residency (the gallery holds PL insurance) - please provide details.

Residency Benefits:

- The opportunity to work within an inspiring space within a collaborative creative precinct to produce a project and/or body of work.
- Sponsored access to 140sqm of warehouse/gallery for the residency period
- An opportunity for an exhibition including opening night to showcase the resulting work to an industry and public audience.
- Curatorial support by the Pin-up team
- Marketing management by the Pin-up team
